I. Introduction.

Matthew 12:34 "... out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks." (NKJV)

- **A.** Our ability to walk in dominion in the earth, to govern, rule and reign over the circumstances in our lives, is directly attributable to our ability to **think** like the King thinks, to **see** like the King sees, and to **talk** like the king talks.
- **B.** The "executable" portion of this dominion walk is comprised of **the words that we speak** into each of life's situation that we face.
- **C.** All of the "thinking" and "seeing" we've accomplished to this point in our lives serves as a reservoir of accumulated experience from which we will choose words to speak in the future.
- **D.** As **God framed the world with His Word** (Hebrews 11:3), so each of us **frames our world with our words.**

As God spoke the world into existence with His Words, each of us has spoken the world that we currently experience, into existence with our own words.

E. At times there appears to be a Christian mindset, based on what we've been taught and how we've internalized these teachings, that when miracles occur, it's always God who is performing them.

This is only partially true. Certainly it is the release of God's power, and His power alone, that enables all miracles to be performed.

But on the basis on God having given man dominion in the earth, it is illegal for God to release His power in the earth without the consent and willing cooperation of a man.

Consider:

1. God didn't slay Goliath. David did.



2. God didn't part the Red Sea. Moses did.



3. God didn't cure Naaman of leprosy. **Naaman,** after he got over his rage, received a cure **when he obeyed the instructions of Elisha.**

What's the point of saying this? So that each of us will seriously consider taking a little more accountability in our lives to bring to pass those things which we strongly desire and believe God is calling us to, rather than sitting on our hands, waiting for God to do it **all.**



- F. Isaiah 55:8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD." (KJV)
 - 1. But they used to be, in the garden.
 - 2. And He wants them to be again!

Romans 12:2 "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind \dots " (NKJV)

II. The Law of Vibration.

A. Everything in the universe is comprised of **energy** and is **vibrating** at a frequency specific to its form.

Vibrate = to oscillate, quiver, move backwards and forwards rapidly; a change of position without a corresponding change in location.

From the smallest to the largest items in the universe, everything is in a state of vibration.



B. The rate at which each element vibrates is called its **frequency.**

Frequency = the number of changes in direction made per second.

The higher the frequency, the more powerful the force which accompanies the vibration.



C. Energy can not be created or destroyed, but it can be changed!

Implication: thoughts can become things!

 $E=mc^2$ expresses the relationship between matter and energy.

D. Thoughts are energy, and once set in motion contain the power to **take form** in the material (mass) world.

When a person is thinking, his brain cells are vibrating.

Every thought has an associated frequency of vibration.

Continued concentration upon a thought increases the amplitude of vibration.

When this happens, the electric waves associated with that particular thought become much more powerful.


"Any idea that is **held in the mind** that is either feared or revered will, begin at once **to clothe itself in the most convenient and appropriate physical forms available." (Andrew Carnegie)**



- **E.** Fleeting or passing thoughts carry very little energy. But thoughts that you think **over and over again,** carry a great deal of energy.
- **F.** Each of us operates like a high powered transmission tower, broadcasting vibrational frequencies that are in perfect synchronization with our thoughts.

These vibrations can be detected by, and they can influence, other people. If we hold the thoughts that create these vibrations in mind long enough, the thoughts will eventually become "things."


G. Since everything in the universe is vibrating, our thoughts, through the power of the Law of Attraction, will draw to us people, circumstances and opportunities that are **resonating on the same frequency** as our thoughts. **Like attracts like.**



Resonate = to correspond closely or harmoniously; to evoke a feeling of shared emotion or belief.

Individuals who think positively (= dwelling on good things that can happen) place themselves in a "positive vibration."

Individuals who think negatively (= dwelling on bad things that could happen) place themselves in a "negative vibration."




H. Images we hold in mind also transmit strong vibrations. These likewise have the power to draw to us, whatever we are continuing to "see" in our imagination.





I. If we send out conflicting vibrations . . . "good" one minute, and "bad" the next, our thoughts are vacillating between different sets of possible outcomes.




The important point here is that we cannot positively resonate and harmonize with the powerful promises of God, if we persist in holding images of the opposite outcomes in mind (i.e., "doubting the promise.")

The bottom line: the influence of the Law of Vibration, when coupled with the Law of Attraction, has very real, powerful, and initially unseen impacts on each of our lives.


The result of that influence is an attraction of people, circumstances and opportunities that manifest in accordance with the vibrational frequencies that we are transmitting, day in and day out.

Quantum: from the Latin word meaning, "How much."




A. Newtonian physics describes the way matter and energy interact at a visible, macroscopic level.



B. Quantum physics, on the other hand, describes the interaction between matter and energy at a subatomic, invisible level.











The model of an atom that we were taught in high school is not correct.

Electrons do not orbit the nucleus . . . rather they are found in **"blurred clouds of probabilities"** around the nucleus.

C. Experiments in Newtonian physics are repeatable. That is, for identical input conditions, you will always get the same output results.

For example, Sir Isaac Newton discovered gravity when he observed an apple fall from a tree.

Holding an apple above the ground and dropping it 100 times will cause it to fall to the ground 100 times, demonstrating the unerring and unfailing power of the law of gravity.



D. In quantum physics, however, the natural, repeatable laws of Newtonian physics no longer apply.

"Whereas gravity works whether anyone is present or not (a tree falls down, not up, even if no one observes it), subatomic particles are not there **unless someone looks** for them...

In the quantum, subatomic arena, **there are only possibilities and probabilities.** Things don't work like you think they should. Nothing is there until you look.

In quantum mechanics, **the observation of something changes it.** You can never really be sure if it even existed before you looked. Because you looked, you actually interfered with whatever was there before you looked . . .this just means that we affect everything around us **by how we see it or by what we believe . . .**

How you interact with this quantum field of possibilities, the unseen realm from which all is created, **determines what manifests in your life.** We have been given an empty slate and Jesus said it is up to us what we choose to put on it." (*Quantum Faith*, Annette Capps)

- E. "Quantum physics says that you can't have a Universe without mind entering into it, and that **the mind is actually shaping the very thing that is being perceived.**" (Dr. Fred Alan Wolf, Quantum Physicist)
- F. "Anyone who is not shocked by Quantum Theory has not understood it." (Niels Bohr, Nobel Prize winning physicist)
- **G.** Hebrews 11:3 "By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible." (NKJV)



"The key to manifesting matter is to interact with that which 'is not' so that it becomes what you hope for. Your expectations and beliefs are of primary importance. If you observe and expect failure, sickness or disaster, that is exactly what will manifest . . .

There are an infinite number of possibilities that exist for your life. You alone have the **power to choose** which possibility becomes reality in your life." (*Quantum Faith*, Annette Capps)


H. "Faith is an unseen energy force. It is not matter, but it creates matter and actually becomes matter . . .

Faith-energized words convert energy to matter. Words are the catalyst that turn the substance of faith into physical manifestation.

Faith is the raw material from which all matter is made. It is the invisible substance from which your physical world was and is created." (*Quantum Faith*, Annette Capps)

- 1. Hebrews 11:1, 3 "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen . . . Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." (KJV)
- **2. Genesis 1:3** "And **God said,** Let there be light: and there **was** light." (KJV)
- IV. The Power of the Spoken Word.
 - A. Spoken words and the Law of Vibration.
 - **1.** When we speak, the **vibration** of our vocal chords causes the formation of **words.**
 - 2. The entire world was created by words from the "Word" of God.


John 1:1-3 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made." (KJV)



but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." (KJV)

We release the **power** of God through articulation of **the Word** of God, **by the vibration of our vocal chords** when we speak His Word in faith.








This "vibration" is equivalent to "wrestling" in the Scriptures.

Ephesians 6:17-18 "And take the helmet of salvation, and the **sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:** Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit . . . " (KJV)



B. Spoken words and quantum physics.

The sub-atomic particles, that exist as "blurred clouds of probabilities" . . . the ones that are not "there" until you start looking for them . . . are waiting for someone to speak to them so that they can start forming themselves into that which is desired, needed, expected, etc.



The Bible expresses it this way:

Genesis 1:1-3 "In the beginning **God created** the Heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. **And God said,** Let there be light: and there was light." (KJV)

Romans 4:17 "... even God, who... calleth (= to incite by word, to call aloud) those things which be not as though they were." (KJV)

C. God's dominion mandate.

"The Spirit awaits direction from the soul." (Val Vandewall)

1. God has established a system in which nothing can happen on earth without the consent of man.

Genesis 1:26 "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion (= to govern, rule and reign) over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth." (KJV)

This statement is **man's legal authority** from God to exercise dominion in the earth. With these words **God placed boundaries of His own right to legally interfere** in the affairs of earth **without the consent of man.**



2. Additional scriptural support for "Let Them:"

Psalm 115:16 "The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's; but the earth He has given to the children of men." (NKJV)

Psalm 8:5-6 "For you made us only a little lower than God, and you crowned us with glory and honor. You put us in charge of everything you made, giving us authority over all things." (NLT)



Isaiah 45:11 "Thus says the LORD, The Holy One of Israel . . . concerning the work of My hands, **you command Me.**" (NKJV)

Matthew 18:18 "I tell you the truth, the things you don't allow on earth will be the things God does not allow. And the things you allow on earth will be the things that God allows." (NCV)

- 3. "Most Christians spend most of the time praying, trying to talk God into doing what He's already done... to give us what He's already given us." (Charles Capps)
- **4. It's already done and you've already won!** (We Win, David Crowder Band)

The greatest **exchange** that has ever taken place in history has occurred in your favor.

Because of what Jesus has already done on the cross:



- a. You have become righteous.
 - 2 Corinthians 5:21 "He made the One who did not know sin to be sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." (Holman)



b. You have been healed.

Isaiah 53:4-5 "But **he endured the suffering** that should have been ours, **the pain that we should have borne.** All the while we thought that his suffering was punishment sent by God. But **because of our sins he was wounded**, beaten because of the evil we did. **We are healed by the punishment he suffered**, made whole by the blows he received." (TEV)



c. You have become rich.

2 Corinthians 8:9 "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, **yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich** (= to become wealthy, be increased with goods)." (NKJV)

5. Now all you have to do is to **believe** in the finished work of Jesus.

John 6:28-29 " 'What can we do to perform the works of God?' they asked. Jesus replied, 'This is the work of God: that you believe in the One He has sent.' " (Holman)

Mark 9:23 "Jesus said to him, 'If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.' " (NKJV)



2 Corinthians 1:20 "For **all the promises of God in Him are Yes**, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us." (NKJV)

D. How do we execute and walk in the dominion God has given us?

1. By speaking faith filled words!

Exodus 14:15 "Then the LORD said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? **Command** the Israelites to start moving." (NCV)



2. By calling those things which be not as though they were.

Romans 4:17 "(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were." (KJV)

- a. There is no greater principle in the Bible to bring about healing, prosperity and success than the principle of calling those things that are not yet manifested, as though they were already manifested.
- b. In Scripture, God always said it before He did it! The power lies in "saying" it.

It only took three verses in the first chapter of Genesis before God began to call those things that were not as though they were.

Genesis 1:3 "And God said, Let there be light: and there was light." (KJV)



Joel 3:10 "... let the **weak** *say*, I am **strong."** (KJV)

c. Matthew 9:23-24 "When Jesus arrived at the official's home, he noticed the noisy crowds and heard the funeral music. He said, 'Go away, for **the girl isn't dead; she's only asleep.'** But the crowd laughed at him." (NLT)



d. Mark 4:36-41 "Now when they had left the multitude, they took Him along in the boat as He was. And other little boats were also with Him. And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling. But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?"

Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" And the wind ceased and there was a great calm. But He said to them, "Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?" And they feared exceedingly, and said to one another, "Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!" " (NKJV)



E. Faith is released in words.

1. Whatever is in our hearts in "abundance" is what will come out of our lips.

Matthew 12:34 "... out of the abundance of the heart (= the thoughts or feelings of the mind) the mouth speaks." (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 4:13 "And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak," (NKJV)

2. Spiritual power is released through words.

John 6:63 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. **The words** that I speak to you are **spirit**, and they are **life**." (NKJV)

Luke 17:6 "So the Lord said, "If you have **faith** as a mustard seed, you can **say** to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." (NKJV)




3. You can have what you say.

Mark 11:23 "For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith." (KJV)

"I told My people they can have what they say, but they are saying what they have." (The Lord to Kenneth Hagin)

There is tremendous **power released in your words** when you **say what God said,** and do not doubt in your heart.



F. The power of God's Word.

1. It upholds all things.

Hebrews 1:3 "who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and **upholding** (= to bear, carry, bring forth) **all things by the word of His power...**" (NKJV)

2. It is the seed of the new birth.

1 Peter 1:23 "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever." (KJV)

3. The word is alive and powerful.

Hebrews 4:12 "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." (NKJV)



4. The Word, and the Word alone is what God is ready to perform.

Jeremiah 1:12 "Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am ready to perform My word." " (NKJV)

5. Only the Word can accomplish the Lord's will.

Isaiah 55:11 "So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but <u>it</u> shall accomplish what I please, and <u>it</u> shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it." (NKJV)

6. The Word is what the Lord confirms.

Mark 16:20 "And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming (= to prove its truth and divinity) the word with signs following." (KJV)

7. The Word is what God sent to heal and deliver His people.

Psalm 107:19-20 "Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. **He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions."** (NKJV)

8. The Word is the sword that the Spirit uses in warfare.

Ephesians 6:17-18 "And take the helmet of salvation, and **the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:** Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit . . . " (KJV)

Jesus defeated the Devil by **speaking God's Word** to him: "It is written . . . it is written" (Matthew 4:3-11)

9. The Word is the "dunamis" power of God.

Romans 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for **it is the power** (dunamis . . . miracle working power) **of God** to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek." (NKJV)

10. The Word is what the Angels listen for and respond to.

Psalm 103:20 "Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, **hearkening** (= to hear intelligently, attentively and with understanding) unto **the voice of his word.**" (KJV)

11. The Word brings protection.

Psalm 17:4 "Concerning the works of men, by the word of Your lips, I have kept away from the paths of the destroyer." (NKJV)

12. Satan knows and fears the power of the Word, and tries very hard to keep you from speaking it.

Mark 4:14-16 "The sower sows the word. And these are the ones by the wayside where the word is sown. When they hear, Satan comes immediately and takes away the word that was sown in their hearts." (NKJV)







G. The power of your words.

1. The words of your mouth control your destiny.



Proverbs 18:21 "Death and life are in the power of the tongue..." (KJV)

Matthew 12:37 "For by your words you will be justified (= to be made free), and by your words you will be condemned (= to be held in bondage)." (NKJV)

2. Your words determine the course your life will take.



James 3:2-5 "... If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body. Indeed, we put bits in horses' mouths that they may obey us, and we turn their whole body. Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires. Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things ..." (NKJV)



3. Your words can bring an early death and loss of rewards.

Psalm 106:32-33 "They angered the LORD at the waters of Meribah, **and Moses suffered** because of them; for they embittered his spirit, and **he spoke rashly with his lips."** (Holman)



4. They can be sweet to the soul and health to the bones.

Proverbs 16:24 "Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and **health to the bones."** (KJV)



5. They can cause us to overcome, or to be destroyed.

Revelation 12:10-11 "And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, **and by the word of their testimony...**" (KJV)

Proverbs 18:7 "A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul." (KJV)

"My Spirit has been driven out by the words of men. Words, words, words. Many have called Me Lord, Lord, who have not done the things that I said. Discourage too much talk. Deeds live, and re-echo down the ages – words perish." (God Calling, April 23)

V. The Problem.

A. Speaking words that are out of line with the King's words.

Proverbs 10:14 "Wise men lay up knowledge: but **the mouth of the foolish is near destruction."** (KJV)

B. Saying what we feel like saying (when we're distressed), instead of what God said.

James 3:5-6 "So also, the tongue is a small thing, but what enormous damage it can do. A tiny spark can set a great forest on fire. **And the tongue is a flame of fire.** It is full of wickedness that can ruin your whole life. It can turn the entire course of your life into a blazing flame of destruction, **for it is set on fire by hell itself."** (NLT)

C. Complaining when things aren't going our way or happening fast enough to suit us.

Numbers 11:1 "The people soon began to complain to the LORD about their hardships; and when the LORD heard them, his anger blazed against them. Fire from the LORD raged among them and destroyed the outskirts of the camp." (NLT)

Psalm 77:3 "I remembered God, and was troubled; **I complained**, and my spirit was overwhelmed." (NKJV)

VI. The Solution.

God told us in the Bible and has shown us through science the importance of our words.

A. First, change what's in your heart.

Since what we say comes out of the abundance of what is in our heart (Matthew 12:34), work on the heart first.

Psalm 1:2-3 "But his **delight** is in **the law of the LORD**, and in His law **he meditates day and night.** He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper." (NKJV)


Romans 10:17 "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (NKJV)

B. Spend time alone with the Lord each day.

Just sit in His presence and behold Him.

2 Corinthians 3:18 "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord." (NKJV)

Psalm 17:15 "As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness." (KJV)



C. Speak and pray the solution, not the problem.

Your job is to **declare what you want,** and put some **faith** behind your words.

Matthew 8:8-10 "The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel." (KJV)



D. Give thanks in advance and keep a grateful heart.

Romans 4:20 "But Abraham never doubted. He believed God, for his faith and trust grew ever stronger, and he praised God for this blessing even before it happened." (TLB)

"As you focus on **sincere gratitude** for several minutes at a time, **you will move your frequency** to one of the most powerful frequencies there is, and **all good things will begin to appear in your life!"** (Rhonda Byrne)


1 Thessalonians 5:18 "be thankful in all circumstances. This is what God wants from you in your life in union with Christ Jesus." (TEV)



E. Keep a tight reign on your lips.

Proverbs 10:19 "In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, **but he who restrains his lips is wise."** (NKJV)

James 1:19 "...let every man be swift to hear, **slow to speak**, slow to wrath;" (NKJV)




VII. Close.

A. Be a good soldier . . .

2 Timothy 2:3-4 "Take your part in suffering, **as a loyal soldier of Christ Jesus.** A soldier on active duty wants to please his commanding officer and so does not get mixed up in the affairs of civilian life." (TEV)

B. And line up with God's Word.

"Line up, line up,
I will walk on the line that your Word has defined,
Line up, line up.
I'm declaring Your Word to every corner of my world,
Line up.



To every mountain that stands in my way, To every cloud that darkens my day, I will overcome it all when I open up and call – Line up, line up!"

Line up with Him in your thinking, in your seeing and in your saying!

And your life will never be the same again!
